Learning Goals	Skills Developments
LISTENING:	 Understand short dialogues, instructions, expressions and phrases of daily use if spoken clearly and identify the general issue of a speech we talk about known topics; Comprehend short multimedia texts by identifying keywords and the general sense.
SPEAKING:	 Describe familiar people, places and objects using words and phrases already memorized by listening and or reading; Refer to simple information relating to the personal sphere, integrating the meaning of what is said with body language; Interact in a comprehensible manner with a familiar classmate or adult, using expressions and phrases appropriate to the situation.
READING:	 Reading and comprehending texts level A1, preferably accompanied by visual aids, understanding their overall meaning and identifying familiar words and phrases.
WRITING:	 Write short essay in comprehensible form to introduce oneself, one's family, habits or send greetings, to thank or invite someone, to ask or give news; Write short messages to a correspondent reusing structures and vocabulary already encountered.
